



Virtual Putnam Co Family YMCA Turkey Trot FAQ

- ✓ **Will I still get a shirt?**
 - Everyone is guaranteed a long-sleeve, performance race shirt
- ✓ **Can I get a refund since it is virtual?**
 - All registrations are non-refundable for this event.
- ✓ **Can I still run the regular route with my family/friends?**
 - The Turkey Trot race course will not be marked or policed. We advise participants to choose a route with little to no traffic, such as a neighborhood or park.
- ✓ **When and where will packet pick-up be?**
 - Packet pickup is located curbside at Avery Trace Middle School (across from the YMCA) the following day and time: Wednesday, November 25 from 12 pm - 6 pm. All remaining race packets can be picked up at the YMCA after Thanksgiving Day.
- ✓ **Can my kids still participate and get a medal?**
 - Ages 12 and under can register for the Gobble Wobble. No medals will be given this year.
- ✓ **Why is it important to still run this race?**
 - The Turkey Trot is our largest fundraiser each year. Our YMCA depends on these funds to make a meaningful, lasting impact right here in our community through programs like Learn To Swim, Open Doors and Cancer Recovery. By running the Turkey Trot, you ensure a brighter tomorrow for men, women and children who call our region home.

- ✓ **Do we get a race bib?**
 - Yes! A race bib will be included in your race packet.
- ✓ **Will there be medals or trophies?**
 - This year we will not have place-winner medals; however, we will have contest prizes leading up to Thanksgiving Day. Be sure to follow us on Facebook to enter! The Largest Colony Trophy will still be awarded to the largest team that is registered. So tell your family and friends to register with the same team name!
- ✓ **Do I have to run/walk Thanksgiving Day at 8am?**
 - Participants can run anytime during Thanksgiving Weekend.
- ✓ **Do I submit my race time?**
 - You do not submit your time, but we would love for you to share pictures of your race on our Turkey Trot Event Page!
